The Missoula Montana Airport (MSO) is located 5.6 miles from downtown Missoula. Air carriers include Alaska/Horizon, Allegiant, American, Delta, Frontier, Sun Country and United, providing nonstop flights to 15 major markets.

Transportation within Missoula is a breeze with various rentals car agencies, ride share offerings like Uber and Lyft, airport shuttles and the Mountain Line, Missoula's public bus system with free ridership.
